

546 Jesus' invitation to enter his kingdom comes in the form of parables, a characteristic feature of his teaching. Through his parables he invites people to the feast of the kingdom, but he also asks for a radical choice: to gain the kingdom, one must give everything. Words are not enough, deeds are required. The parables are like mirrors for man: will he be hard soil or good earth for the word? What use has he made of the talents he has received? Jesus and the presence of the kingdom in this world are secretly at the heart of the parables. One must enter the kingdom, that is, become a disciple of Christ, in order to "know the secrets of the kingdom of heaven". For those who stay "outside", everything remains enigmatic.

Revival's in the air

Our world is hurting; yet, amid our fallen world, Christ is present. Jesus radically tells us in John 6:41 that "the bread that I give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Revival is a grassroots effort to bring this radical, life-giving promise to the world, inspiring a "movement of Catholics across the United States who are healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist." We are now in the Year of Parish Revival, fostering "Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit." This will lead into in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years from July 17-21, 2024 in Indianapolis, which will be followed by a year of going out on mission "for the life of the world."
