



PART ONE: THE PROFESSION OF FAITH SECTION TWO I. THE CREEDS

CHAPTER TWO I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST, THE ONLY SON OF GOD.

Article 5"HE DESCENDED INTO HELL. ON THE THIRD DAY HE ROSE AGAIN"

Paragraph 2. ON THE THIRD DAY HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD

638 "We bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this day he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus." The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ, a faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross:

Christ is risen from the dead!
Dying, he conquered death;
To the dead, he has given life. I. THE
HISTORICAL AND TRANSCENDENT EVENT
639 The mystery of Christ's resurrection is a real
event, with manifestations that were historically
verified, as the New Testament bears witness. In
about A.D. 56 St. Paul could already write to the
Corinthians: "I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for
our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and
that he was buried, that he was raised on the
third day in accordance with the scriptures, and
that he

appeared to Cephas, then to the Twelve. . . "The Apostle speaks here of the living tradition of the Resurrection which he had learned after his conversion at the gates of Damascus
