



Examination of Conscience

My Life With God The Lord says: "You shall love the Lord your God with your whole heart."

Do I participate in Mass by singing and responding with devotion? Do I leave Mass early? Do I use God's name with respect? Do I use bad language? Do I try to learn about my Catholic faith through reading and pondering His mysteries? Or, I am content to live an adult life with a child's understanding of religion? Do other people respect and love God because of my example? Or, have I caused scandal by my words and actions?


My Life With Others The Lord says: "Love one another as I have loved you."

Have I a genuine love for others? Do I do to them what I would not want done to myself? Do I reverence all human life? Am I kind and attentive to my spouse and children? Do I respect and obey my parents? Do I get along with my brothers and sisters? Do I share my time, talents and possessions with others? Am I sensitive to the needs of the poor, elderly, the sick, or people of other races? profession, job, or school am I hard working? Have I been honest? Have I been lazy? Have I cheated anyone? Do I respect all who bear the burden of leadership in the Church and State? Do I pray for them? Have I been truthful and fair? Have I injured others by lies, gossip or name-calling?
